



15. IBA WORLD RANKING

- 15.1. IBA World Ranking points for each Boxer are accumulated over a two (2) year "rolling" period.
- 15.2. IBA World Ranking points are awarded for each Competition as listed below and maintained in full for four (4) Competitions.
- 15.3. From the 5th Competition onwards (up to a maximum of 7 Competitions), the overall lowest IBA World Ranking point awarded are decreased by 25% per Competition.
- 15.4. The Official IBA World Ranking is issued after each Competition counting into the ranking system.
- 15.5. Every Boxer participating in IBA-owned and IBA-sanctioned Elite Competitions, except for IBA Olympic Qualifying Events for the Olympic Games is ranked within the Competition and gains points depending on final result and position.
- 15.6. For Men and Women, IBA World Ranking points are allocated for the following listed Competitions:
 - 15.6.1. Olympic Games
 - 15.6.2. World Championships
 - 15.6.3. Continental Multi-Sport Games
 - 15.6.3.1. All-Africa Games
 - 15.6.3.2. Asian Games
 - 15.6.3.3. European Games
 - 15.6.3.4. Pan American Games
 - 15.6.3.5. Pacific Games
 - 15.6.4. Continental Elite Championships
 - 15.6.5. World Boxing Tour events (Gold Belt, Silver Belt, Bronze Belt)
- 15.7. The ranking points allocation table:

15.7.1. The above-listed ranking points are adjusted for the Continental Championships based on the number of Boxers in each Weight Category as follows:







- 15.7.1.1. Seven (7) Boxers or less: fifty percent (50%) deduction from abovelisted points
- 15.7.1.2. Eight (8) to eleven (11) Boxers: thirty percent (30%) deduction from above-listed points
- 15.7.1.3. Twelve (12) Boxers or more: No deduction
- 15.8. Extra criteria (Men and Women)
 - 15.8.1. Any Boxer who changes Weight Category is awarded seventy-five percent (75%) of all points granted in the previous Weight Category.
 - 15.8.2. Two (2) Boxers with the same number of points are firstly ranked by the number of Competitions in which they participated.
 - 15.8.3. If two (2) Boxers have the same number of points gained in the same number of Competitions, they are ranked through the best result in the highest ranked Competition as follows:
 - 15.8.3.1. World Championships
 - 15.8.3.2. Olympic Games
 - 15.8.3.3. Continental Elite Championships

16. **RESULT PROTOCOL**

16.1. In IBA Competitions, Boxers' results are classified as follows:

16.2. In an IBA Competition where box-off Bout for the third (3rd) place is organised between the two (2) losers of the semi-finals, the Boxers result must be classified as follows:

4	4	Loser of the Box-off Bout for the third (3rd) place
5	5	Loser vs Gold in Quarter-Final (QF)

5	7	Loser in QF vs the Boxer ranked third (3 rd)
5	8	Loser in QF vs the Boxer ranked fourth (4 th)
